

## PUERTO Natales - Roald Amundsen



The Roald Amundsen cruise ship called at the capital of the Última Esperanza Province during the first week of April.



During their stay, passengers enjoyed two days of excursions, visiting protected natural areas such as the Cueva del Milodón Natural Monument and Torres del Paine National Park, where they took part in hikes of varying difficulty levels.

## PUERTO Natales - Aurora Expeditions



The Aurora Expeditions cruise ship called at the city of Puerto Natales at the beginning of the month to offer excursions of varying difficulty levels, including the traditional full-day tour of Torres del Paine National Park and the Base Torres trek, as well as visits to less-traveled areas such as the Lazo-Webber sector, located within Torres del Paine National Park.

Passengers spent one night in different areas of the Park, giving them the opportunity to spend more time exploring and gaining a deeper understanding of the region. This experience also allowed them to discover less traditional and less-visited areas which, although often left out of standard itineraries, are equally remarkable for their beauty and unique character.
