

## THE PEACE BOAT VISITED THE CITY OF PUNTA ARENAS

The city of Punta Arenas received a notable visit on January 31 and February 1 with the arrival of the renowned Peace Boat cruise ship, carrying more than 1,600 passengers, which anchored at Mardones Pier in the regional capital. During both days, passengers took part in a wide range of excursions, including visits to various estancias, excursions to the Strait of Magellan Park, and city tours, where many passengers explored the city and visited several museums such as Maggiorino Borgatello and Nao Victoria.

For this reason, part of the team accompanied them and coordinated the timing of the tours around the city and its surroundings.
